Program Focus:

The Anti-Terrorism Intelligence Awareness Training Program (AIATP) is a one day, introductory awareness program designed to provide line officers and first-line supervisors with a working knowledge of the criminal intelligence process and applicable laws, guidelines, policies, tools, and techniques. Knowledge gained in this course will aid in the detection of pre-incident indicators related to terrorist activity in the community that may be encountered during the course of their law enforcement duties. Other topics include Terrorist Use of the Internet and an Overview of Terrorism. A portion of this training program is specific to terrorist activity in the region where the training is delivered.

Training Topics Include:

- Increased knowledge of terrorism
- Awareness of groups and activities that pose a threat to the safety and security of personnel
- Awareness of critical resources which are available and located in the officer's jurisdiction
- Review of the SAR Initiative

Who Should Attend?

Full Time Law Enforcement Officers (especially first line officers and supervisors including: patrol officers, detectives, and narcotics officers and their supervisors). State, local, campus and tribal law enforcement personnel are encouraged to attend.
