**Description:** This course is presented by the Center for Domestic Preparedness, in cooperation with New Mexico Tech, Energetic Materials Research and Training Center. Initial Law Enforcement Response to Suicide Bombing Attacks (ILERSBA) was developed with support and cooperation from the Department of Homeland Security, National Bomb Squad Commanders Advisory Board, and New Mexico Tech to provide front line Law Enforcement Officers with the skills and knowledge to effectively interdict and respond to an imminent suicide bombing attack (person-borne or vehicle-borne) or a non-suicide attack involving a vehicle-borne device.

**Target Audience:** Primarily for participants that have completed basic law enforcement training and, where applicable, on-the-job training under the supervision of a departmental training officer. All participants must have demonstrated successful performance as a patrol officer in a U.S. state or local law enforcement agency. All participants must have sufficient tenure remaining in their current or future position to allow for the application of course material upon their return. Other emergency response personnel may attend at the discretion of the program host and this agency.

**Registration:** *Participants should enroll by **14 Aug 2010** in order to secure a place in the class, and to ensure the course minimum is met. Registration may occur after this deadline, but there will be no guarantee of available seats.*
